All Municipal Band concerts are free to the public. The auditorium opens at 7:30 pm.

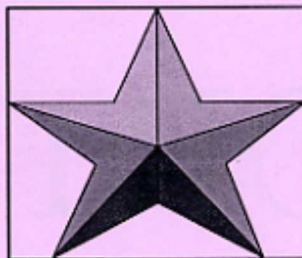
